Fast CAT is open to all Irish Setters, 12 months of age or older that are individually registered/listed with the AKC registration as purebreds, Foundation Stock Service (FSS) dogs, Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) dogs, and AKC Canine Partners. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to compete. Dogs may only **run once**.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee may disallow a dog's entry.

At roll call, all dogs will be measured by a ruler to verify handicaps. **All bitches in season or, dogs lame and unfit with be excused.** In such instances where a dog is excused by the committee, applicable entry fees will be refunded.

Fast C.A.T is a lined, straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Each dog is held at the start line approximately 30 feet from the lure. The coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line into a catch area. The course is completely fenced with snow fencing and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed by 2 people with stopwatches to 1/100 sec at the start arm drop by the Hunt Master and the verbal signal “Tally-Ho” to the timers at the finish line. The average of the 2 timers is used in the calculation of the mph rounded to the nearest 0.01.

CALCULATION: $204.545/\text{ave sec} = \text{mph}$.

Handicaps are based on the dog’s height at the withers:

- 18” or greater – Handicap is 1.0
- 12” up to less than 18” – Handicap is 1.5
- Below 12” – Handicap is 2.0
- **MPH X Handicap = Points** submitted to the AKC

The AKC titles are determined as follows:

- BCAT – 150 points
- DCAT – 500 points
- FCAT – 1,000 points
- FCAT# - Each additional 500 points

For AKC sanctioned events, the AKC website will feature the Top 20 Fastest Dogs by breed by Year National standings. The standings are updated as event results are processed. Top 20 dog names can be viewed at www.apps.akc.org/apps/fastcat. Points are accrued by mph earned.

Roll Call

Roll Call will be conducted within 2 hours prior to the start of the event. At this time, 2 inspectors will determine the fitness of all dogs entered for their running of this event. The order of dogs running will be posted.

Start time will begin at the end of confirmation/obedience & rally judging.

RIBBONS

The ISCCC will award a flat paper ribbon for a passing qualifying run. A dog toy will be awarded to the dog with the fastest qualifying score (points).

ISCCC Trial Information

- **ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK**
- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply
- This is a rain or shine event. Please plan accordingly
- All dogs should be up-to-date on their vaccinations
- A plastic strip loop machine will be used
- Only the Fast CAT course on the grounds will be snow fenced
- Restrooms are available on the grounds as well as lunch
- Dogs must be crated or on lead while on the grounds
- The Hunt Master is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of civil disturbance, extreme or dangerous weather, riots or any other cause beyond the control of the event holding club.
- Neither the club or any of its members assume any liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or their dogs or property and assumes no responsibility for injury to spectators before, during or after this event
